BALTIMORE BEND VINEYARD, which takes its name from a nearby bend in the Missouri River, rests along the path of the expeditionary company of Lewis & Clark and parts of the Santa Fe Trail. This area in Northeast Lafayette County marks the southern boundary of glacier fields during the Ice Age. As the ice retreated, blowing winds deposited deep, fertile, silt loam soil that is excellent for growing grapes.
